Part A: Introduction to DOT Compliance

This class is an overview of DOT Compliance. Covered topics include knowledge and introduction into the US DOT, FMCSA, PHMSA, FBI, CIA, and IRS and how they affect you. You will be trained on the MCS-90 and what you promise when you sign it and how to tell if you need an FMCSA registration, DOT number, MC authority, CDL, Drug testing, etc. You will learn the questions and definitions of the MC-150a document. Lastly, you will understand your responsibility with regard to safety management controls to include the following 6 topics; Drug and Alcohol Testing, Driver Qualification File, Hours of Service, Maintenance, and an introduction to the accident register and required driver training.

Part B: Audit Survival

You will gain knowledge and be prepared for a DOT Safety Audit and a Compliance Review. You will understand how to be ready for an audit and what goals your company should have while undergoing an audit. You will learn how to set priorities when it comes to being prepared, where to start, and what to do while they are there and after they leave.

Part C: Understanding Violations and Negotiating Fines

Do you know what the potential violations that you can acquire when undergoing an audit? In this portion of the class, you will receive the list of violations as well as how to negotiate any fines.

Part D: State DOT Regulations

This looks at the State-specific DOT regulations and restrictions and how they relate to the FMCSA regulations.
