

This is an example of a SAP Sheet – this is what you give a driver when he has a positive drug test – you put your company name etc at the top and bottom.

## **The “SAP Sheet”**

Is a list of professionals offering Substance Abuse Professional (SAP) services to employees who have tested positive on a random drug test, or who have violated the DOT / FMCSA D & A rules in some other way.

It is a good idea to include the following verbiage in your “SAP sheet.”

*By providing this information to an employee,  
(name of Motor Carrier) is in no way agreeing to pay  
for services.*

The services of a substance abuse professional may result in a driver being eligible for a truck driving job in future.
